Background: The Kampala City Authority completed new roads in various areas in Kampala and contracted TASS to supply, install and maintain the solar street lights in the new roads

TASS Role: TASS was the main contractor for this project. We procured all the equipment from our trusted suppliers around Europe and Asia. Our team of experienced foremen/ technicians was then deployed to the sites to carry out civil works and electrical installations on all sites. Quality of work was supervised by a team of our certified engineers.

Overall the project was handed over successfully to the client.

Key Facts:

- Each solar street light had battery capable of lighting the street for three days autonomously
- A Maintenance contract for 5 years was signed between KCCA and TASS.
- Aside from the installation and the maintenance costs, the new solar lights put up by TASS are fully powered by Solar. The district does not have to pay any electricity bills, which saves them money in the long run.
- Solar Street Lights will enable night travel along the road without having to worry about insecurity.
- The roads where TASS installed solar streetlights were Wansaso, Katwe, Bahai and Kibuye Road.
