

INSTALLATION OF 600 STREETLIGHTS IN MASAKA TOWN

Background: Combining the urgent need for lights in the district and a leaning towards improving security in Masaka, Ministry of Energy and Mineral Development contracted TASS to install street lights in the district.

TASS Role: TASS was the main contractor for this project, and worked hand in hand with the Masaka Municipal council. Using equipment garnered from Europe and Asia we were able to deploy a team of certified engineers and foremen to the site to erect the street lights and the transformers.

Overall the project was a success.

Key Facts:

- Over 600 street lights in total were set up, including both single and double armed light mounting.
- The street lights that were erected in Masaka managed to cover 70% of the municipality in light this included Nyendo, Katwe Bypass, Hobart Street, Main straight, Masaka Hospital area.
- Security in the town has since improved after this installation.
