Background: TASS was sub contracted by the South African company BATTECH in order to install solar systems in the provinces Niassa and Inhambane which each had various districts under them, totalling 207 in number, for the client FUNAE.

**TASS Role:** TASS was the subcontractor for this project. All the equipment used was supplied by BATTECH industries and TASS's role then was to use our own team of experienced foremen/ technicians to carry out installation of the solar systems. The project was handed over successfully to the client.

Key Facts:

- 207 types of solar systems were installed, 1 for every district
- Primary schools, Health centres and villages were the main type of facilities that had solar systems installed.
- TASS was able to install systems for public schools (classrooms and the like), Health Centres, Public Administration Buildings, Police Posts, Street Lights, Commercial fridges, Residential Houses and houses with around 4 lights.
- This project benefited hundreds of thousands of people in making their general day to day lives safer.
